College Fee Waivers and Transcripts

If a senior needs to send their transcript to a college they must follow the steps below:

1. Go to the BHS main page website
2. On the left side you will see College Fee Waiver/Transcript Request
3. Complete both forms for each college you are requesting a transcript for
4. Send both forms to Ms. Perez our registrar at aperez@bps.k12.nm.us
5. Send one email per college so if you are requesting transcripts for two colleges then you will send two emails, one with the forms for college A then one email with the forms for college B

FAFSA

The time to start the FAFSA application is now. Students and parents can now obtain their FSA ID number which is needed before starting the FAFSA application. Every 1st Monday of the month is Money Monday where students and parents can obtain assistance with completing the FAFSA. This is another great source to receive assistance.
