Dear Students, Parents, Guardians, and Family Members,

As many of you have heard, the NMPED has issued a full re-entry plan and toolbox, as well as, an expectation of all districts to return to full-reentry of 5 days a week for any students that are desiring to return to in-person learning. A district letter of student re-entry and safety expectations is attached to the email previously sent and will be posted on our BHS website. Our bell schedule, for the remainder of the year, is attached to the email previously sent and will be posted on our BHS website. Classes for online and in-person learning will return to a start time of 7:30am and an end time of 2:30pm.

Our BPS School Board has voted and determined that all students that are desiring to return to in person learning will be expected to show up to school starting on Monday, April 12<sup>th</sup>, after Spring Break. Full online/remote learning is still available to all students that are desiring this option.

We need students to identify their intent of returning to full re-entry or staying fully online. There is not an in between option. Students need to decide to return to all 5 days or to stay online all 5 days. If a family's choice does change in the future, we do require communication with administration, before the change of learning environment occurs. Please complete this survey by Wednesday, **March 24<sup>th</sup>**.

### **Important Dates:**

- Week of **March 29<sup>th</sup> through April 1<sup>st</sup>**– there will be no hybrid, in-person learning (all classes will be taught remotely online)
- **March 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>** – Asynchronous Learning Days (no Google Meets)
- **March 31<sup>st</sup> and April 1<sup>st</sup>** – Synchronous Learning Days (Live, online instruction according to current, hybrid bell schedule)
- **April 2<sup>nd</sup>** – No School
- **April 12<sup>th</sup>** – First Day of In Person, Full Re-entry (no more asynchronous days)

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## **Important Reminders:**

- All students (in-person and remote/virtual) will be meeting 5 days a week following a traditional bell schedule from 7:30am to 2:30pm. Students are expected to stay on campus for the entire day unless they have late arrival or early dismissal on their schedule. Students may not go back and forth between remote/virtual and in-person learning.
- All students are to bring their chrome books, along with their chargers and ear buds, to school every day, fully charged.
- Parents/Family Members will be required to individually screen for health concerns before students leave home. On any given day, should your student not feel well, please have them join class virtually and not send them to school.
- Masks will be required at all times, except when eating or drinking. Water is the only thing allowed in classrooms.
- Students will need to social distance to the greatest extent possible and are not to congregate while on campus. Students are to go to class immediately after eating breakfast and must leave campus immediately at the end of the day.
